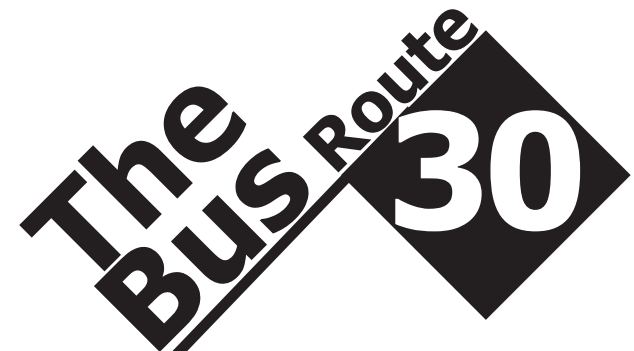
Passes

If you are a frequent rider of The Bus, you may want to consider purchasing a pass. Passes do not have a time limit. Transfers are issued free when the driver checks the pass.

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT ROUTE 30:

The new **Route 30** bus will travel along the route shown on the map (heavy black line). Set bus stops are indicated by the stars. You can get on the bus at any of these stops.

Also, If you live within the **GREY** zone shown on the map, you can **call for a pick up** by an Athens Transit bus which can:

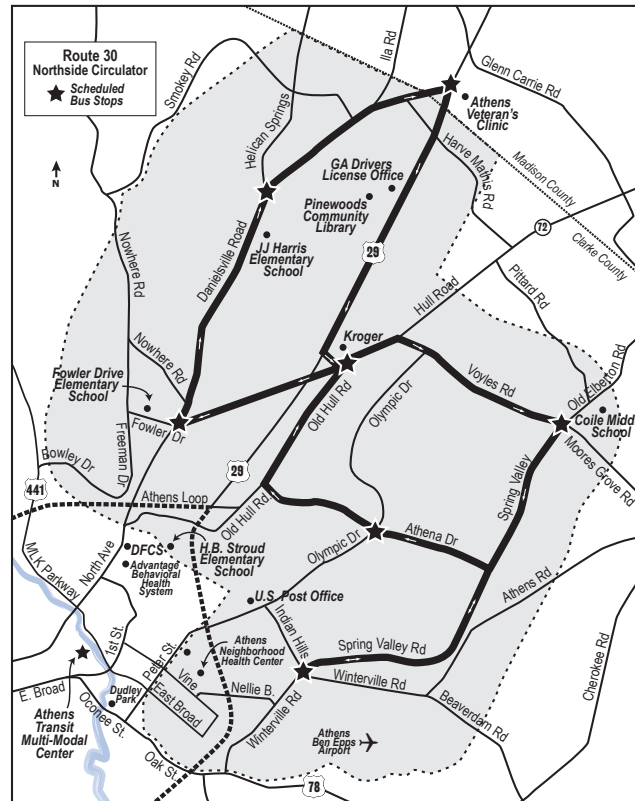
- Pick you up from a designated location. The operator will tell you where to go to catch the bus when you call.
- Take you to anywhere along the designated circular route within the zone
- Take you to where you can transfer to another Athens Transit Bus. Route 30 can connect with these other routes:

- Bus 1 - North Avenue (at Fowler & Freeman)
- Bus 8 - Barber/Chase (at the CVS on North Ave)
- Bus 24 - Athens Tech (at Kroger)

If you are not near one of the designated stops but you live within the **GREY** zone, you must call for a pick up at **706-613-3439** at least an hour before you need a ride.

Dial-A-Ride Services are not available anywhere in Madison County.

Operators will help you schedule your ride and let you know where to go to catch the Route 30 Bus.

How to Ride the Bus



- 1 Find your location on the map.
- 2 Check the timetable for the closest timepoint to your location. If you will be catching The Bus at a stop not listed in the timetable, plan to arrive at your stop by the time listed for the preceding timepoint.
- 3 Read the timetable from left to right and top to bottom.
- 4 If you need to take more than one bus to reach your destination, ask your operator for a transfer.
- 5 Use exact fare. The operator cannot make change.
- 6 To indicate your stop, pull the cord located at the top of the windows or press the black strip between the windows.

Bus-N-Bike



ATS "Bus n' Bike" program makes daily commuting much easier, safer, and more convenient for cyclists. Special carriers on the front of the bus allow riders to easily store bicycles while riding. Each carrier can hold at least two adult-size bikes. For detailed information on how to load and unload your bike visit:

Type the address above into any browser at home or on your mobile device. This takes you to a real-time view of the ATS system on OTvia2™. The location of every bus and stop along all routes is represented on the map. The positions of the buses are updated automatically every few seconds. You can also see the estimated arrival times at each stop. So if you are waiting for a bus or wondering just how close the next bus or bus stop is, check out this app.
