

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ATHENS-CLARKE COUNTY,
GEORGIA WITH RESPECT TO **HISTORIC PRESERVATION – HISTORIC
PRESERVATION COMMISSION – POWER TO ADOPT RULES OF PROCEDURE;**
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The Commission of Athens-Clarke County, Georgia hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 8-5-2, entitled “Historic Preservation Commission,” paragraph (e), entitled “Historic Preservation Commission’s Power to Adopt Rules of Procedure,” is hereby amended by deleting said paragraph in its entirety and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

“(e) *Historic preservation commission's power to adopt rules of procedure.* The historic preservation commission shall adopt rules for the transaction of its business and consideration of applications; shall provide for the time and place of regular open meetings, with proper public notification, and for the calling of special meetings; and shall provide a list of types of applications for which the historic preservation commission staff may issue certificates of appropriateness. The historic preservation commission shall adopt rules of procedure with approval from the mayor and commission. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the members. The latest edition of *Roberts' Rules of Order* shall determine the order of business at all meetings.”

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
