Our class is participating in an exciting literacy and conservation project called Little Lily's Pad Hop. With the support of the Athens-Clarke County Water Conservation Office, we will have a new guest in the classroom. Her name is Little Lily and she is an adorable stuffed frog who serves as the ACC water conservation ambassador. Throughout her time in the classroom, Little Lily will hop from one child's pad to another, learning how each family uses water in their everyday lives.

When Little Lily visits your home, your child is asked to do three simple tasks: 1) count the number of water using items in the house, 2) pick one of three books (provided) to read to Little Lily during her stay, and 3) write and illustrate (draw, paint, photo, etc.) a journal entry of Little Lily's water adventure with your family. Your child can complete these tasks on his/her own, but we encourage your involvement and contributions to the project.

The overall goals of this project are to promote literacy, family involvement, and efficient water use.
